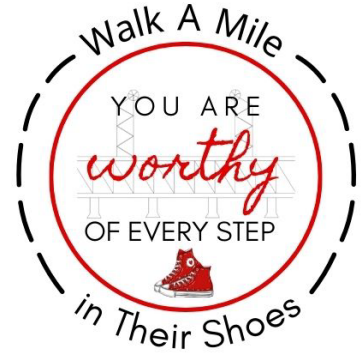

First, we would like to thank you for your participation in our 15th Annual Walk a Mile in Their Shoes event!

As you consider registering and prepare to walk, please take a moment to reflect.

Why do we walk? Whom am I walking for? A son walking for his mother; a sister walking for her brother; an employer walking for his employee.

Walk A Mile in Their Shoes is our community awareness event which sheds light on domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and child abuse. Additionally, it serves as an opportunity to raise funds to assist the River City Domestic Violence Center. Those funds go directly to survivors by way of supplying them with basic needs as they navigate through their journey.

There is no right or wrong way to raise money for this event. Our hope is that each participant will raise a minimum of \$100- this amount will help us reach our financial goal.

Sexual assault, domestic violence, human trafficking, and child abuse does not just affect an individual but can have a ripple effect and impact the survivor's family and community.

In 2021, RCDVC provided support services to 307 survivors of abuse; 43 of whom were children. Each of these individuals affected by domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, or stalking.

Walk A Mile in Their Shoes provides an opportunity for the community to show those who have been victimized that there is support.

- Every **92 seconds** an American is sexually assaulted and physically assaulted every **9 seconds** by an intimate partner.
- **1 in 4 women** have experienced severe physical violence by an intimate partner.
- In 2021, there were **11 reported rapes** in Yankton; RCDVC worked with over **30 survivors** of sexual assault the same year.
- South Dakota has the **3rd highest rape rate in the U.S.**, with 72.6 rapes per 100,000.

Our hope is to bring awareness and support to our community. Let's show survivors that we are here to help and support them!

You are welcome to make a team or walk as an individual!

- Gather your friends, family, co-workers, children, or anyone that wants to make a difference in the lives of victims.
- There is no limit on team size. You can have a team of 2 or 200. Prizes will be awarded to largest team and the team that raises the most money, as well as other categories.
